3. ONGOING PROGRAMS @ NJCF

3.1 SSCP (Scholars Special Coaching Programme)

Empowering Young Minds, Shaping Responsible Futures

The **Scholar Special Coaching Programme (SSCP)** was the **first initiative** launched by the NJ Charitable Foundation in 2015. The program began with the selection of **70 meritorious students** from **Class 4 to 8** of nearby schools in **Udhna** through a rigorous and transparent selection process.

A Lifelong Commitment to Education and Empowerment

A student admitted into SSCP remains under the Foundation's guidance until they **complete their formal education and secure gainful employment**. The program aims to nurture a generation of youth who embody the **RISHEY** values – **Responsible, Independent, Self-reliant, Honest, and Esteemed Youth**.

Vision & Core Objectives of SSCP:

- To help each child come into confident possession of their **innate talents**
- To develop **skills for academic and real life success**
- To also work towards **mental, emotional and spiritual development of the students**
- To foster **positive transformation** in a child's behaviour, language, attitude, and personality
- To create a **stimulating and innovative learning environment**
- To enhance **memory power, emotional intelligence (EQ), and spiritual quotient (SQ)**





Our Approach:

We believe that every child is unique, possessing individual talents and abilities. SSCP offers a nurturing and structured environment that brings out the best in each student. Through personalized coaching, free learning resources, and life skills training, students thrive both academically and personally.

At the Foundation's premises, students receive:

- A free and focused learning environment
- Support from trained teachers and mentors
- Access to skill development programs, spiritual sessions and value-based learning

Current Status (as of April 2025):

- 271 students are currently enrolled and actively benefiting from the program
- 40 new students have been selected for the upcoming academic year 2025–26
- We are proud to share that the NJ Group has successfully employed 12 SSCP alumni

Participation in International Olympiads

Empowering Young Scholars Through Global Competitions

In the academic year **2024–25**, **NJ Charitable Foundation** achieved a significant milestone by being officially recognized by the **Science Olympiad Foundation (SOF)** as a registered center to conduct Olympiads. The institution was allotted the **ID Code GJ 9087**, enabling its scholars to compete on a global academic stage.

The Hindi Olympiad was introduced for the first time by SOF in 2024–25.

28.61% of NJCF scholars who participated in the Hindi Olympiad won Gold Medals, a testament to the Foundation's emphasis on multilingual excellence.

Looking Ahead

With growing interest, rising performance, and institutional support, **participation and results are expected to rise further** in the academic year **2025–26**. NJCF remains committed to nurturing academic excellence and preparing its scholars for success on national and international platforms.

Stream Selection & Competitive Exam Support - Higher Secondary Education

At SSCP, students make informed decisions about their **stream for Standard 11 and 12** after attending NJCF's **Career Guidance Seminars** and participating in **one-on-one counselling** sessions with experienced teachers and mentors.

To support students beyond stream selection, **NJCF has developed a comprehensive process** that includes personalized mentorship, curated study resources, and continuous guidance for a range of competitive exams:

Support for Science Stream Students:

- JEE Mains & JEE Advanced
- NEET

Support for General Stream Students:

- CLAT (Law)
- IPMAT (Management)
- Other National-Level Entrance Exams

This structured approach has shown **remarkable outcomes—with several students successfully gaining admission to NITs and Government Engineering Colleges**. NJCF continues to be a guiding force in helping students realize their academic and professional aspirations.

The SSCP continues to be a cornerstone initiative of NJCF — a program rooted in compassion, built on commitment, and dedicated to shaping confident, capable, and compassionate citizens of tomorrow.

The Foundation has modified the SSCP project and added a new dimension while inducting class 1 students with the **Open Basic Education** of the **National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS)**. Let us understand briefly about NIOS.



3.2 National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) An Innovative Home Schooling Concept

NIOS is an autonomous organisation under the Ministry of Education, Government of India.

NIOS offers Open Basic Education at the primary school level students and also offers education to the Secondary and Senior Secondary Students.

Open Basic Education (OBE) programme is where one learns at their own pace and with several language (medium of instruction and qualification) options and choice of subjects.

NJCF started the OBE program at its learning center in Surat in the academic year 2022-23 and currently 60 students are enrolled in the program.


The OBE programme admits students in 3 levels, viz. -

1. Level A (Class I - III equivalent)
2. Level B (Class IV - V equivalent)
3. Level C (Class VI - VIII equivalent)

NIOS students are admitted at the age of 6 yrs.





Regular Enrichment Activities:

In addition to the academic curriculum, a range of regular activities ensures holistic learning:

- Art & Cultural Activities
- Yagya (Spiritual Practice)

To support students' **spiritual and personal development**, spiritual learning is an integral part of the curriculum.

Saturday Creative Activities:

Under the guidance of dedicated teachers, students participate in engaging, hands-on activities every Saturday, such as:

- Best from Waste
- Music
- Rakhi Making
- Rangoli Making & Presentation

These help students gain practical life skills and encourage creativity.

Health & Nutrition:

For the **holistic physical and mental development** of each child:

- Nutritious meals and milk are provided daily
- Physical growth is regularly monitored

Milestone Achievement:

We are proud to share that in **March 2025**, the **first batch of 30 students appeared** for the OBE **Level A Examination**, marking a significant step in their educational journey.

Expansion of Efforts:

The Foundation has also launched the **Secondary Programme under NIOS** at **Sarvoday Trust's Ashram Shala in Pindval**, continuing our mission to extend quality education to more learners.





3.3 SAKSHAM-Empowering Professional Aspirations

The **Saksham Program** was initiated by **NJ Charitable Foundation** in the academic year **2018–19** to support students aspiring to build careers in professional fields such as:

- Chartered Accountancy (CA)
- Cost and Management Accountancy (CMA)
- Company Secretary (CS)
- Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA)

A Structured Pathway for Self-Driven Success

The Saksham initiative is designed to promote **self-learning**, with the support of a well-structured system that includes:

Curated learning content developed by **in-house educators** and reputed **professional institutions**

Access to **facilitators and expert faculty** to guide and monitor progress

A **pre-planned daily schedule** that encourages discipline and time management

Daily Learning Routine

Students enrolled in the Saksham Program follow a rigorous **daily routine** at the **NJCF Learning Center**, from: **7:00 AM to 7:00 PM**

This immersive and focused environment fosters deep learning and sustained academic engagement.

Progress Tracking

Regular examinations and assessments are conducted to measure student progress and readiness for professional exams.

Personal mentoring ensures that each student receives the guidance they need at every stage.

Impact and Current Status

We are proud to share that the Saksham Program has proven to be a great success. As of 1st April 2025, 36 students are actively pursuing their professional qualifications under this initiative.



In 2016, NJCT Volunteers visited our school to select students who were passionate about learning and had dreams of doing something in life. I was in 8th grade and assumed it was just another tuition class. But since many of us couldn't afford private tuition along with school, I gave the entrance exam a try – and I got selected. Back then, my school started at 10:30 AM and NJCT classes were at 7:00 AM. What surprised me was the setup – only 10 students per class, each subject taught by different teachers. This smaller class size helped us communicate freely and clear our doubts easily. It wasn't just a tuition class – it was a place that encouraged self-study, understanding concepts deeply, and growing together.

Over time, NJCT became more than just a learning center. We had mentors to share our wins, struggles, and doubts. I chose Science as my stream and switched from Gujarati medium to English medium. NJCT supported that transition by helping with school fees and academic guidance. While others prepared for JEE/NEET, I followed my passion for wildlife photography. NJCT supported me without hesitation and even helped me enroll in a photography course that I attended every Saturday for an year – a step that shaped my future path.

NJCT was never only about studies. We had fun, participated in events, and made learning feel joyful. Though our days were long – from 7 AM to 7 PM – they were well-balanced with activities and breaks. We learned life lessons, discipline, and the importance of consistency. Eventually, NJCT became NJCF – a full foundation. Over the years, buildings changed, teachers changed, but their mission never did. NJCF continued to grow stronger, now supporting over 500 students with 10–15 teachers, all working toward one goal: making education free and accessible.

NJCF has supported me beyond just academics – they've helped me mentally, emotionally, and financially. I often say, "I must have done something good in my past life to have found NJCF... or maybe they found me." 
